An applicant must have completed all on-campus requirements in an APA accredited, degree-granting clinical, counseling, or school psychology doctoral program in the United States by the time the internship is scheduled to begin. The applicant must also have been awarded a Master's Degree during their training. The applicant must have successfully completed supervised practicum experiences and relevant graduate coursework in, including individual intelligence assessment, learning and development, psychotherapeutic interventions, and research/statistical analysis. Experience working on medical teams beneficial but not required.

To be considered, applicants must be verified as ready to apply for internship by the Director of Training of his or her graduate program, as listed in Part II of the APPIC application form.

Experience working in a medical setting helpful but not required.

For the **Adult Health Track** applicants are expected to have experience with psychological assessment and intervention with adults across age ranges (e.g., young adult, adult, middle-aged, and/or geriatric) and in a variety of settings. Experience working in a medical setting helpful but not required. Interest and/or experience in working with patients with substance use disorders preferred.
